CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICATIONS

A. TriStar Skyline Medical Center, Nashville (Davidson County), TN - CN1909-035

For the initiation of mobile positron emission tomography (PET) services up to 2 days a week at the campus of TriStar Skyline Medical Center located at 3441 Dickerson Pike, Nashville (Davidson County), TN 37207. The applicant is owned by HCA Healthcare, Inc. The estimated project cost is \$610,000.

B. St. Thomas West Hospital, Nashville (Davidson County), TN - CN1909-039

For the initiation of Cardiac PET/CT services at Saint Thomas West Hospital, 4220 Harding Pike, Nashville (Davidson County), TN 37205. The applicant is ultimately owned by Ascension Health Alliance. The estimated project cost is \$1,640,673.

For the establishment of a single specialty ambulatory surgical treatment center (ASTC) limited to oral and maxillofacial surgery and dentistry with three operating rooms and no procedure rooms located at 500 28th Avenue North, Nashville (Davidson County), TN 37203. The applicant is owned by Adam S. Pitts, M.D. The estimated project cost is \$4,559,044. OPPOSITION: Oral Facial Surgery Center, Inc., dba Specialty Surgery Center

D. +Oral Facial Surgery Center, Inc., dba Specialty Surgery Center, Nashville (Davidson County), TN - CN1909-034

For the relocation of a multi-specialty ambulatory surgical treatment center (ASTC) from 322 22nd Avenue North, Nashville (Davidson County), TN, 2 miles west to 410 42nd Avenue North, Nashville (Davidson County), TN. The ASTC has 3 operating rooms (ORs) at its current location and plans to expand to four ORs and 3 procedure rooms (PRs) at the proposed location. The applicant is an "S" Corporation owned by Jeffrey B. Carter, M.D., D.M.D. At some point after licensure it is planned that The Surgical Clinic, PLLC will take ownership and change the business structure to a limited liability company. The estimated project cost is \$10,279,970.09. OPPOSITION: Nashville Midtown Surgical
